BEHIND THE SCENES OF SERVICE

"If anyone has a love for golf and the life lessons that the game teaches you, please consider volunteering your time to impart those lessons to the kids in the First Tee program."

My name is Bobby Kincaid, and I've been a volunteer coach with First Tee - West Texas since the Spring 2024 session. My personal golf journey began in college when I took golf as a PE requirement at 19 years old. I had been a baseball player through HS and had never touched a golf club until then. After starting my work career, I was being invited to a number of golf events, so I began working on improving my



game – at first, through books & magazines (Ben Hogan's "Five Lessons", Harvey Penick's "Little Red Book", etc.), and then was fortunate to have personal lessons with some top instructors in the country (Betsy Cullen, Dick Harmon, Hank Haney, etc.) while living in Houston. I also began playing in USGA Public Links tournaments and was required to understand the "Rules of Golf" to play in a more formal format.

When I started a family, I introduced my children to golf at a very early age, as I think it's a game that can be played for a lifetime. As I got older, I began focusing more on the "mental & attitude" part of golf, as I could see my children watching my reactions during play as much as the performance & scoring aspect. When I moved to Midland in 2012, I was still able to play as a member of a private club, but I resigned from the club in 2019 and began missing the opportunity to play & practice. By the time First Tee - West Texas was organized and opened, I had become a grandfather and thought FTWT would be the perfect spot to introduce my grandsons to the game along with other children who would not have had any other places to play & practice.

I really like how the First Tee program promotes life lessons in golf, and hope that I can impart some of those life lessons to the youngsters in the program in a way that they can take into their everyday lives, on and off the course.
